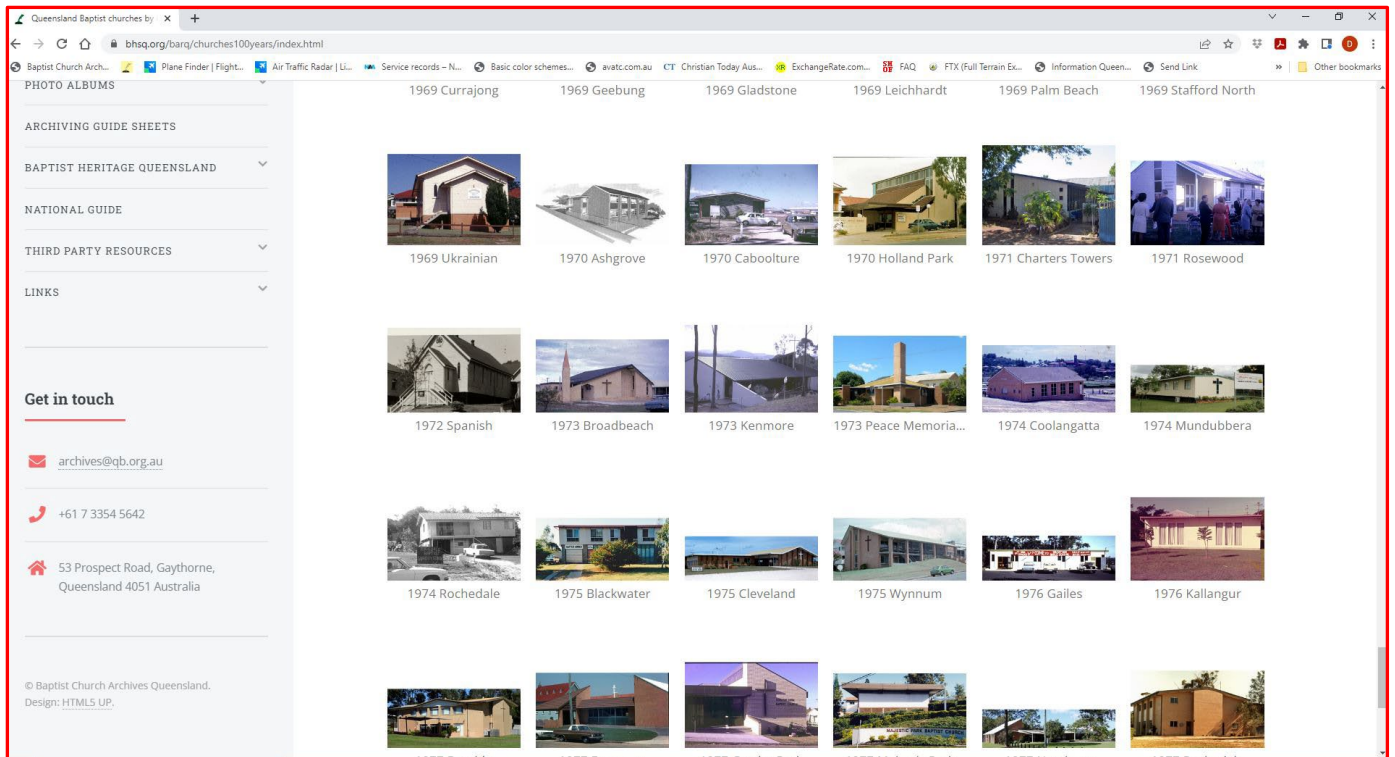


Baptist Churches Photo Album reaches 250 Images

Baptist Heritage Qld and the Baptist Church Archives have recently added another batch of images to their on-line Baptist Churches Photo Album taking the total number to about 250.

This large collection of images now displays photographs of all the Baptist churches in Queensland up to 1980. The latest additions covered the decade of the 1970s. There are just a few for which photographs are not available. Assistance is welcome in finding these.

Each of the photos has been sourced from the holdings of the Baptist Archives and various personal and local church sources. The images are arranged chronologically, and each one has been verified as to the date of opening of the church, although this information is not displayed on the web page. Thanks is expressed to many people who have supplied vital information to achieve this result.

Images are generally restricted to the main original church building and any replacements (either on the same site or elsewhere) and excludes ancillary buildings such as halls. Work is continuing on later batches, but in more recent years, records and photographs are increasingly hard to locate. Contributions for the 1980s are especially invited.
